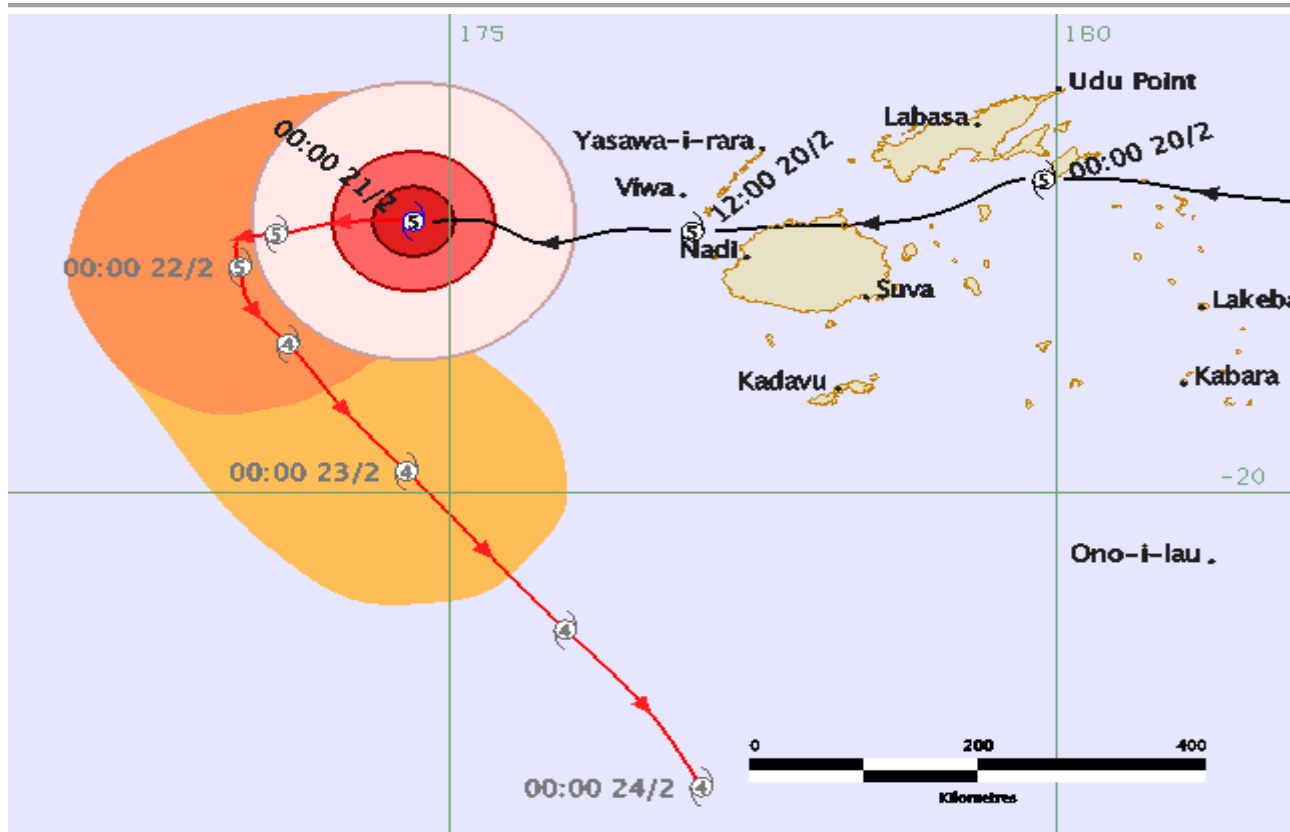


This Situation Update is issued by the National Emergency Operation Centre and covers the period from 1600 hours to 2400hours, 22/02/2016.

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Shift handover at 1800hrs
- Curfew enforced until 0530 am on 22/02/2016 for all the travelling public
- Press interview Director National Disaster Management Office
- Nadi River burst its banks at 2100hrs; Flooding
- 7 missing at sea in Yasawa I Rara; went on a fishing excursion

## WEATHER OUTLOOK



Gale Warning remains in force for Viwa Island. Strong wind warning remains in force for the rest of Fiji waters. Damaging heavy swell warning remains in force for low lying coastal areas of Fiji. Severe Tropical Cyclone Winston Category 5 with average speed of about 65km/hr and momentary gusts to 90km/hr was located near 17.4 South 174.1 East or about 300km West of Viwa or about 360km West of Nadi at 5pm today. On this track TC Winston is expected to be located about 380km West of Viwa at 5am tomorrow.

## GENERAL COORDINATION

- National and Divisional Emergency Operations Centre are on full operational order.

- All response agencies are on stand-by at the NEOC and DivEOC which includes the Republic of the Fiji Military Force, National Fire Authority, Fiji Corrections Service and Fiji Navy.
- Fiji Volunteer First Respondent (FVFR) is on call at the NEOC attending to emergency medical and other rescue services.
- Critical Agencies have opened their respective EOC's but maintain close coordination with NEOC through frequent Situation updates
- Fiji Procurement Office has been assigned to look after Logistics.

## DIVISIONAL UPDATES

### Central Division

- The Divisional Emergency Operation Centre (DivEOC) was activated following an instruction from the National Disaster Management Office (NDMO) on Thursday 11/02/16 of the impending TC Winston.

- ❖ All our District EOC has been brief on the weather update and has activated at 1600hrs.
- ❖ Upper Southern Lau has been advice to take precautions and confirm their Evacuation Centres. TNK's are advice to make sure that all punts and fibreglass boat are to be anchored on safe ground

**NOTE**

Fallen trees have closed roads throughout all divisions and isolated flooding is occurring.



FRA's contractors are currently clearing all main roads and emergency service access roads then will be concentrating on feeder roads to ensure access is restored. Due to the extent of debris on roads combined with electrical wires it is very slow to make progress through some sites. This combined with the significant amount of traffic and pedestrians in Suva and Lautoka who are breaking curfew are restricting emergency services in clearing roads. FRA request increased police pressure to enforce curfew to keep public safe and so that recovery is not impeded.

## **Water Authority of Fiji**

### **❖ CENTRAL/EASTERN REGION**

- Central Eastern Update has been delayed and limited due to FEA Power Loss at Wailoku Water Supply Depot. New updates are highlighted in red.
- Suva/Nausori •150mm Burst main at Nadali Village
- FEA Power restoration is Critical for Waila Raw and Clear Water Pumps in order to boost reservoir levels. Current low reservoir levels at Tovata, Kalabu, Nasinu, Flagstaff and Toorak will remain if only two pumps are operating for Wainibuku Reservoir.

### **❖ Labasa**

- FEA Power Outage causing Nakama Borehole to shut down
- Nil Flow was recorded from Naselevu raw water, Navau only 6" inflow and Nakama borehole will be activated by workshop team today in to Benau reservoir (FEA blackout)(Supply reservoir - 0.2m and reserve res - 3.00m)
- An operation has been carried out last evening to close some distribution valve to Basoga, Bulileka and Rara as to prioritise the supply of water to the main business areas and hospital.

- Listed below are some of the areas that will be affected with low pressure and also no water during this period of shut down. Bulileka, Basoga, Vunivau, Soasoa, Rara, Lajonia, Wailevu Village, Bucalevu and Qelewaqa.
- Water Carting is being arranged for these areas.
- The operation stand by team will wait for the water to be receding at Dogoru River so they can proceed in checking the Nasealevu burst main complaints.
- The entire network problem was also affected due to power shutdown so at the moment we using backup generator from last night till this morning to monitor the situation in the North.

❖ **RESOURCES OF THE WATER AUTHORITY OF FIJI**

- All resources of the Authority will be available for emergencies 24/7. These are
- Fresh water Package Plants on Standby.
- Generators on standby.
- All key personnel in the region is on standby for any emergencies.
- Also a Water resources team is continuously monitoring all water sources and updating on weather forecast.

**WAY FORWARD**

---

- Up to date baseline data is critical at this stage as we intend to calculate the extent of damages caused by TC Winston.
- The National Emergency Operations Centre is heavily reliant on information provided by the Divisional Emergency Operation Centre.
- Total support needs to be rendered to the Divisional Coordinators to ensure timely dissemination of data for comprehensive response planning.

**CONCLUSION**

- The National Emergency Operations Centre will continue to receive and consolidate situation updates from Divisional and Sectoral Emergency Operation Centres in order to both coordinate assistance to affected areas and also inform decision makers.
